





### FLOOR STYLES & SPECIES



Style: MIDNIGHT Species: WHITE OAK

A strong hardwood with coarse texture and deep grain. Stained wood varies from steel blue to charcoal. Topcoated wood is darker.



Style: SILVER LINING Species: ASH

A strong hardwood with coarse texture and deep grain. Wood is light tan but stained wood is light gray. Stained wood grain is visible and a dark gray. Unsanded grain shines like silver.



Style: RIVERROCK Species: MAPLE

A strong heavy wood with a tight, uniform grain pattern & smooth surface. Varies in color from white to brown and stained varies from medium to light gray.



Style: PEACOCK Species: WALNUT

A class all its own, with a rich, smooth grain and deep color. A very durable hardwood. Stained will be nearly black with sapwood lighter.



Style: IOWA TAN Species: HICKORY

Strong, hard wood with prominent grain, dramatic color shifts from gray to tan in the same panel. Stained wood has random color shifts ranging from from gray to tan.



Style: MIST Species: SMOOTH DOUG FIR

Grain varies depending on how wood was cut- quarter sawn wood is straight and flat sawn grain is wild. Stained wood will range from silver to medium gray with green undertones with apparent grain.



Style: SMOKE Species: SMOOTH DOUG FIR

Softwood with grain changing depending on how wood was cut- quarter sawn wood is straight and flat sawn grain is wild. Stained wood will be deeply saturated with highly visible grain.



Style: BARK Species: CHERRY

Originally wood is light to medium with undertones with a uniform grain and pattern. Stained wood will be a deep, d warm gray. The Sapwood will be lighter
